- Please maintain good hygiene standards: wash your hands and refrain from eating behind the bar.
- Taxis home will **ONLY** be provided for staff working until the **end** of each session, and due to the cost, normally only to **LE11 and LE12 postcodes** Taxis will normally be booked for 12.30 am to allow for cleaning and cashing up. These need to be booked before when submitting this form with your address and sufficient notice is needed of any changes.
